Action Outline #3 Local Pastor Completion of Studies & Orientation to Ministry

Action:	The dCOM certifies the completion of the prescribed studies and the Orientation to Ministry to the candidate and the BOM, and the candidate is to be listed in the conference journal as eligible to be appointed as local pastor.
The bishop awa	ards the license as a local pastor only when an appointment to a pastoral charge is made

Suggested Motion: Move that _______ be certified as having completed

the prescribed studies for licensing as a local pastor (pending completion of those studies and the Orientation to Ministry) that he/she be listed in the conference journal as eligible for appointment, and that the bishop award the license as a

local pastor if and when appointed.

Note: "Pending completion of those studies" shown above in parentheses should be

included when action is taken before the candidate has completed licensing

school and/or Orientation to Ministry.

Requirements:

(see ¶ 316).

- 1. Certification as a candidate for ministry (see Candidacy Certification, ¶ 310).
- 2. The Orientation to Ministry.
- 3. Completed studies for the license as a local pastor or one third of the work for a master of divinity degree.
- 4. Been examined (interviewed) by the dCOM.
- 5. The candidate must receive approval of the BOM and provide the BOM with a satisfactory certificate of good health.

Persons awarded the license as a local pastor shall be classified as one of the following:

- 1. Full-time local pastor (¶ 318.1)
- 2. Part-time local pastor (¶ 318.2)
- 3. Student local pastor (¶ 318.3)

Note: Approval for licensing must be renewed annually (see Continuance as a Local Pastor, ¶ 319).
